9. Reservation

Scheduled Caste [SC] & Scheduled Tribe [ST]	 a) SC-16.25% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for SC applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.: 01/06/2015], see Annexure-4 b) ST-22.5% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for ST applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.: 01/06/2015], see Annexure-4 c) The reserved seats are not interchangeable between SC & ST. d) SC/ST applicants selected for admission on their merit shall not be counted against reserved seats. e) However any modification made by the Government in the reservation policy will be followed during admission. 	
Persons with Disability (PwD)	5% of sanctioned seats shall be reserved for PwD students with exter disability not below 40% (Blind and Low Vision, Hard of Hearing, Locomo Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid At Victims and Muscular Dystrophy, Autism, Intellectual Disability, Spe Learning Disability and Mental Illness). [G.O. 10161/HE, Dtd.: 07/04/20 see Annexure-4.1	
Ex-Serviceman [ESM], Serving Defense Personnel [SDP], Children of Martyrs [CoM]	1% of the sanctioned seats shall be reserved for Self/ Children/ Wif Husband/ of Ex-Serviceman, Serving Defense Personnel and Children Martyrs. [G.O. 10161/HE, Dtd.: 07/04/2018], see Annexure-4.1	

10. Weightage

Number of seats in each stream, filled up by the applicants with weightage, shall not exceed 10% of the sanctioned strength. This 10% of seats shall be proportionately distributed among all categories of applicants. An applicant, who is selected with weightage and taken admission, shall continue to remain in this 10% bracket, even if cut-off mark is reduced in subsequent selections. Maximum 10% weightage mark shall be provided to an applicant.

10.1 NCC

- a) Applicants holding B Certificate shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or Equivalents examination.
- b) Applicants who have represented the State or the Central School/Sainik School at the All India level NCC Camps / Courses / Activities shall be given weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or Equivalents examination.
