About S.K.C.G. Autonomous College

S.K.C.G. Autonomous College, Paralakhemundi, established in 1896 under Raja Goura Chandra Gajapati Narayana Deo, embodies the vision of the former rulers of Paralakhemundi to advance education in Odisha. Initially, the college obtained affiliation as a second grade college from the Madras University and it became a first-grade institution in 1936 due to the persistent efforts of Maharaja Sri Krushna Chandra Gajapati Narayana Deo. The college later affiliated to Andhra University and became one of the first five colleges under Utkal University in 1943. In 1947, Government of Odisha takeover college and renamed the college after its foster father and patron Sri Krushna Chandra Gajapati. Since 1967, it has been affiliated with Berhampur University. Recognized as a Lead College in 1990, it celebrated its centenary in 2001. Offering UG and PG courses across Arts, Science, Commerce and AEDP program, it achieved autonomous status in 2002 and NAAC accreditation in 2004, continuing to provide quality education aligned with NEP 2020 to meet contemporary needs.

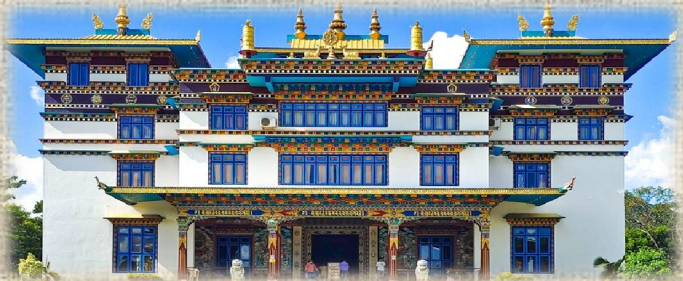
Paralakhemundi Tourism

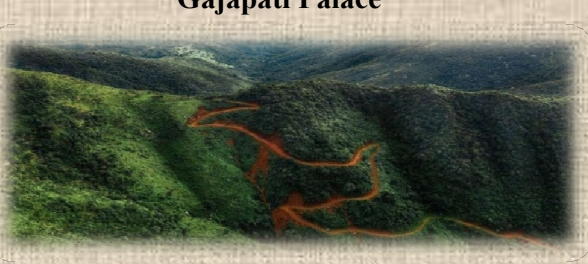
